

NV-ASA BOARD MEETING

October 27, 2019 Minutes

In attendance were Paul and Carolyn Beck, Diane Marcus, Lars Larson and Joanne Neckel. Meeting called to order at 3:45 pm.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the proposed 2020 calendar of events.

Paul Beck presented the Treasurer's Report. Balance as of 10/27/19 is \$32,232.36. See attached.

The Becks and White's Nursery continue to propagate azaleas in order to provide sufficient quantities for the future.

Work on the Klimavicz Legacy Garden continues at Meadowlark. The signage needs to be confirmed and completed. Various workdays will resume in spring. There is a requirement that the Club provide 20 hours of volunteer labor during the growing season.

Azaleas were donated to the Jenkins Arboretum in Pa. Plants were sold at Ayr Hill, Green Springs Gardens, Bonsai Day, member sales, fall sale and auction, plant exchange and NC. Carolyn suggested that perhaps one or two sales be held at Meadowlark during Klimavicz bloom season. Carolyn suggested that we have the fall sale fliers printed for the Green Spring sale.

The Becks were asked to donate azaleas to the ARS conference in Gettysburg September 2020. The Becks would like to donate 25 Marshy Point 20-gal plants plus other miscellaneous plants to Potomac Valley Chapter of ARS who would then donate them to Londontown in Md. Board approved this donation.

Several members continue to care for numerous plants at their homes. Transitioning of project over the next few years as Becks scale back.

The Satusuki seminar is delayed until 2022.
