As you are aware, the chapter has been supporting the development of a Legacy Garden at Jenkins Arboretum in Devon, PA. We have donated 216 Holly Springs azaleas over the past three years.

On 18 October, **Steve Wright**, Director of Horticulture / Curator of Plant Collections and **Jake Summers**, Hamilton Educational Fellow, and project manager of the Holly Springs Legacy Garden, picked up an additional 26 azaleas donated by **Paul** and **Carolyn Beck**. These were large, mature azaleas...many over 30 years old. They will serve as a backdrop for the smaller azaleas previously donated.

It is anticipated that the Holly Springs Legacy Garden will be formally dedicated next spring.
