On Thursday, April 3rd, we held a workday in the Klimavicz Legacy Garden at Meadowlark Botanical Gardens (MGB) in Vienna, Virginia. The day started out a little damp due to some much needed rain during the night and into the early morning hours, but the air dried a little and the temperatures were fairly comfortable. So the six NV-ASA volunteers, along with a crew from MBG, were able to get a huge amount of work done.

In Section A (the original area) we raked the leaves, put down Holly Tone around all the Klimavicz azaleas, removed some tough Liriope that had spread into what will be a planting space for more Klimavicz hybrids, did a little pruning, weeded, and spread leaf mulch.

In section B we moved large rocks to the back of the bed, discarded small rocks, and

did a little weeding.

Over the summer, we are going to work on completing a design layout for both sections in preparation for fall planting.


